When the amount available allows, please order in increments of 3 plants - orders of less than three are subject to a 20% upcharge NOTE - 1 gallons that are priced \$25.00 or more will be exempt.

1 Gal - L.S. - late shift - suitable in height for pot size but not fully rooted at the time of listing, caliper, branching and overall body will be somewhat diminished as compared to standard 1 gallon

1 Gal - F.S. - fresh shift - not rooted at the time of listing, all originating from a small cell or tube tray container

1 Gal - Liner - equal in height, body and caliper to a single season plant grown in a tube tray or graft pot

1 Gal - Usz - usually under 6" tall and sometimes down to just a few inches

1 Gal - 6" - usually 6-10" or 6-12" tall

1 Gal - Hvy Liner - not fully formed but far enough along that once flushed out in the spring it will approach a standard 1 gallon size plant
