

Handy Nursery Plant List

Common Name	Cut Leaf Horse Chestnut
Botanical Name	Aesculus hippocastanum 'Laciniata'

Form and Flower	Small deciduous tree, generally upright and usually taller than wide with moderate growth rate. The 10" long creamy white conical panicles appear in May-June and are highlighted with hints of pink and yellow.
Foliage and Fruit	Extraordinarily fine foliage type. Green leaves are very slender and deeply incised. So much so that some are left with a wisp of of a leaf surrounding the mid rib. The fall color is yellow, not spectacular, but not grocery bag brown like some of the other Horse Chestnut forms.
Size	Height 20 to 25' Width 15 to 20'
Zone	3 to 7
Special Notes	Foliage issues normally associated with Horse Chestnut do not seem to be a prevalent in this cultivar.
